**Philosophy and Approach:** I believe that everyone has an innate capacity to heal and recover from the emotional and spiritual injuries we experience in life. Counseling is one means to engage and facilitate this healing process. I employ an eclectic approach that draws from developmental theory and attachment theory, complimented by Level I EMDR training for the treatment of trauma, as well as experience and training in treating addictions (substance abuse and process addictions such as sexual addiction), cognitive-behavioral tools, emotional regulation techniques, communication practices, and assertiveness training.

**Formal Education, Training, and Licenses:** I hold a Master’s Degree in Counseling (1996, focus on community mental health) from Denver Seminary. Major course work included human growth and development, diagnosis and treatment of mental health issues and community dynamics, and foundations of personal growth and spiritual formation. I have applied my education and training in the field of addictions treatment as a dual diagnosis counselor in both inpatient and outpatient drug and alcohol treatment settings, as a chemical addictions Clinical Supervisor, and now as a private practitioner. I am a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) in Oregon, a Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) in Washington, and a National Certified Addiction Counselor level two (NCAC-II) credentialed by NAADAC, the Association for Addiction Professionals. I have completed EMDR Level I training for trauma recovery and also have 30 plus hours in supervision training.

**Continuing Education, Ethics, and Supervision:** As a licensee in the State of Oregon and Washington, I am required to participate in continuing education; for details of requirements go to the Oregon web site at <http://www.oblpct.state.or.us/> and the Washington web site at <http://www.doh.wa.gov/>. I also abide by the *Oregon LPC/LMFT Code of Ethics* adopted by the Board noted below, and the *Washington Administrative Code (WAC) and the Revised Code of Washington (RCW)*. I periodically receive supervision by consulting, on an as-needed basis, with qualified professionals who are also bound to uphold client confidentiality.

**The Client Bill of Rights:**
